Whereas the festival of Dusshera, Deewali and Chhath Pooja etc are coming in forthcoming days. It is anticipated that people shall celebrate the forthcoming festivals by bursting of firecrackers in the jurisdiction area of West Distt., Delhi. Directions have been issued under Section 31(a) of AIR (Pollution Act, 1981) read with Rule 20 (6) of the AIR (Pollution and Control of Pollution) (Union Territories) Rules Act 1983 regarding bursting and sale of all kind of crackers. In view of the directions dated 01.12.2020 issued by NGT Tribunal, Delhi in O.A. No. 249/2020 titled, "Tribunal on its own motion Vs. Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change and Ors.", imposed total ban against sale and use of all kinds of firecrackers during COVID-19 Pandemic in the NCR and all cities/towns in the country where the ambient air quality become poor or more than poor category.

As per directions issued by Delhi Pollution Control Committee vide letter No. DPCC/(10)(10)(39)/leg/2019/91-103 dated 28.09.2021, there is strictly ban on sale and bursting of all kinds of firecrackers in the NCT of Delhi upto 01.01.2022. However, all permanent fireworks licenses issued by Licensing Unit were placed under suspension vide Order No. 1081-1110/Jt. CP/Lic. (Expl.) dated 07.12.2020 are still suspended.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the virtue of Section 144 Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 (No. 2 of 1974) read with Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi's Notification No. U-11036/(i)/UTL dated 09.09.2010, I **(URVIJA GOEL) IPS, DY. COMMISSIONER OF POLICE, WEST DISTRICT, DELHI**, do hereby prohibit the sale and use of firecrackers before, during and after Dusshera, Deewali and other forthcoming festivals. If any person contravene this order in the jurisdiction of West District, he/she shall be liable to be punished in accordance with the provision of Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

As the notice cannot be served individually upon all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of the public through press and affixing copies on the Notice Boards of all ACsP/Sub-Division (West District), all SDOs/West Distt, Tehsil Offices of the Districts and the offices of the SDMO, PWD and DDA.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect and shall remain in force for a period of 60 days i.e. up to 11.12.2021 unless withdrawn earlier.
